Revised medical care and translated document fees for our Overseas Patients

We have equally been providing necessary medical care to all patients regardless of their nationalities.

To provide more comfortable medical care for our increasing overseas patients, we decided to revise the fees for medical care and the translated documents as described below.

Effective from: **July 1, 2018**

Details of revision: **Medical fee 1 point = 15 yen**

*Japanese medical fee is basically calculated by a medical point.

Translated documents

[English] 10,000 yen / Medical certificate for insurance

5,000 yen / Regular medical certificate

1,000 yen / Receipt certificate

[Chinese] 1,000 yen / Receipt certificate

[Korean] 1,000 yen / Receipt certificate

*Please ask the staff in charge the fees for the other documents.

*8% consumption tax will be added to both medical care and document fee.

Applicable to: **Medical fee**

Overseas patients who do not have any Japanese health insurance
and who are not covered by TRICARE through US Military

Translated documents

All patients who require a translation

*Even Japanese patients will be charged the revised document fee in case they require a translation.
